The Location:

The congress takes place in the Wachau Valley region of Lower Austria, famous for its vineyards and UNESCO-world-heritage listed status. The venue is a meticulously renovated and restored 17th century monastery in the city of Krems, a bustling regional city with a thousand-year history that is now a modern centre for arts, culture and education. Wandering the streets of Krems takes one on a proverbial tour of European history; the city has been recognised as a model city for historical preservation by UNESCO. The region offers a multitude of attractive destinations for excursions, including a boat tour down the Danube river through the Wachau Valley with wine tasting or museums and galleries.
